Statement on Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive

RoHS Compliance

To our customers:

MAC Panel is committed to being an environmentally responsible Company. Our support of the RoHS directive is part of our overall plan to meet or exceed regulatory requirements for the handling, recycling and the reduction of hazardous materials in our products. MAC Panel will comply with all applicable laws and regulations; including the European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive as it pertains to our products. For product areas where MAC Panel is out of scope of the legislation, MAC Panel's Design for Environment initiative will guide efforts to reduce hazardous materials in new designs and products. It is important that our employees, customers and suppliers know MAC Panel continues its strong commitment to protecting and improving the environment for future generations.

The European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU restricts the use of six substances in electrical and electronic products: Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI), Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs) and Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDEs). Product compliance is assured when considering the application of the appropriate EU RoHS exemptions.

In cases where customers require parts which are not RoHS compliant, manufacturing and storage of these components are segregated to prevent contamination of RoHS compliant parts.

MAC Panel is continuously working with our supply chain partners to ensure compliance to restricted material requirements of all products and material supplied by partners.
